Since then they have, by their letter to us of 16/4/16, overridden the informal process thereby triggering the formal process. We have secured pro bono legal aid through Scott Chambers (Chambers Russell per Law Society) and Mr Chambers will attend the formal mediation as part of the preparation of our case.
