The Bower Reuse & Repair Centre has recently launched a crowdfunding campaign to raise \$10,000 to provide quality furniture and household items to asylum seekers and their families.

Based in Sydney, The Bower is partnering with Mums 4 Refugees, a 100% volunteer grassroots organisation, who play a crucial role in welcoming and integrating asylum seekers in Australian communities. The House to Home project will provide Bower gift certificates to asylum seekers giving them the dignity of choice in selecting their preferred furniture and household items, which will then be delivered via The Bower truck. With the Mums 4 Refugees networks and The Bower's logistical capacity, together they can assist families with practical needs such as sourcing and delivering large furniture items.
