

A NEW ERA OF **ONLINE PROGRAMS**



Bower Reuse and Repair Centres offers a range of online “Repair Café” sessions

We cover the following issues:

- Furniture i.e. use and maintenance of tools, repair of stool, gluing components
- Electronics i.e. use and maintenance of tools, repair of kitchen appliances, lamps, switches
- Bikes i.e. use and maintenance of tools, safety check, maintenance, repair gears, breaks,
- Clothing i.e. use and maintenance of tools, repair dodgy zip, thorned fabric, buttons, holes

Each session last 1 hour and combines:

- 30 minutes of input by our experts on a specific topic – to be chosen by and agreed with host
- 30 minutes for questions from residents/community facilitated by either the host or us
- Presented by two experts to keep it engaging, interactive and capacity to manage questions
- We operate from our workshops spaces with access to tools and materials
- We provide zoom link and streaming kit for live sessions
- We provide access to recorded session for residents/community

We offer two options:

1. One off online repair session at \$450 + GST per session
2. Series of weekly/fortnightly/monthly repair sessions for \$405 + GST per session

In these fees is include

- Two experts to facilitate and present each session
- Preparation of unique content and demonstration material for each session
- Use of our broadcasting equipment, time to setup and streaming cost via zoom Exclusive
- Use of tools and workshop space from Bower Reuse and Repair centres during live session.
- Responding to questions from audience about items they would like to repair
- Access to a recorded version of the session for host

We recommend that hosts of online Repair Cafes consult with us which topic should be covered and announced to their audience beforehand. This will allow their audience to pick and choose the relevant session for an item they would like to have repaired or learn how to repair it.

Promotion of online Repair Café session and booking of attendees should be managed by the host.
